Note2: There is no need of professional practice to be registered as an Architect in the Nation's Registration Board (Direccion General de Profesiones-México). However to be a **Certified Architect**, it is required to comply with certain conditions. This process of certification is carried out by the professional colleges of Architects. The criteria considers among other things at least 3 years of professional practiced. On ocassion the aplicant must take some continuous education courses to grant its disciplinary updating. Mong others for instance there are: 700 unit courses (8hours/unit). Design works: 60 units; site design, project planning, schematic design: 150 units; scheme development and design: 100 units; appraisement and budget making: 55 units; working drawings and documents: 160 units; drawing proof-reading or specialties counter-sign: 25 units; technical disclourse on construction site, technical supervision, biding process: 60 units; project management: 20 units; academic activities: 50 units.
